Aim:	To enable learners to engage in creative activities using ribbons. Learners will be given tools and materials and encouraged to develop personal approaches that reflect their interests and experience.		
Objectives:	To create an individual wired ribbon rose using selected and applied materials.		
Method:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Trace designs off onto greyboard - 2 backs, 1 with aperture, 2 stands Cut out . Cut aperture + trim. 2. Cut fabric: 3 rectangles and 2 fabric stand pieces. 3. Prepare Sellotape pieces. Cover 2 back pieces. 4. Place 4 spots of glue on front board. Place on wadding. 5. When set trim to edge, cut away centre. 6. Cover with remaining fabric. 7. Cover 2 stand pieces. 8. Glue 2 back pieces together. 9. Glue 2 stand pieces together. 10. Draw inner aperture line cutting line. Cut away leaving 1cm border. 		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11. Snip in tiny segments almost to card edge. 12. Glue ¼ of back of aperture. Stretch snips over to back. Check front. 13. Continue around edge. Cut piece of acetate to frame front size. Glue. 14. Decide on opening edge, and glue 3 sides. Press onto back pieces. 15. Bend back stand hinge and position on edge. Mark cross under hinge. 16. Snip cross, peel back, insert glue, and re-cover with snipped fabric. 17. Glue back of hinge, reposition and leave under heavy weight to set. 	
Success Criteria:			
Cutting greyboard to sized, trimming, preparing materials, using Sellotape, covering templates, making front, assembling			
Resources:			
Christmas cotton fabric, fabric scissors, Sellotape and dispenser, scissors, marker pens, greyboard, templates, acetate, UHU glue, wadding
